Jim Nelson, Brooke Chesney, & Bill Vorhees from Continental School spoke on activity at the school. Brooke is the



coordinator for volunteers helping at the school and welcomes our Club to go one-on-one with students that need the extra help. Bill is the

Technology Coordinator and gave an update on the gift of 65 computers that a Green Valley person funded (\$35,000) for the school. Volunteers also helped in setting-up the computers in the computer lab and for the individual classrooms. Jim, as Superintendent, then noted that the school has doubled in size in 3 years to around 540 students now. This change initiated having a full time Principal and a Business Manager. Jim has also initiated numerous changes in school operations, including a breakfast program so that students start the day with a proper meal. Last year only about 50 students participated in having breakfast and now there are 150, with the number climbing. He has also initiated an early release day, so that once a week, teachers can obtain time for additional training and working with each other for the benefit of the classroom. A

program has been arranged with PCC at the Green Valley Campus to provide enrichment classes for students on early release days. This allows parents who are employed to have their children occupied during this half-day off. A Rotary Jr. Interact club is being formed at the school in the 7th and 8th grades and the goal is to have 16 students in the club by the end of August. Our club provided "seed money" to start this program, with the goal of starting an Interact Club at Sahuarita High School in future years. Jim noted that volunteers are always needed at the school in many capacities.

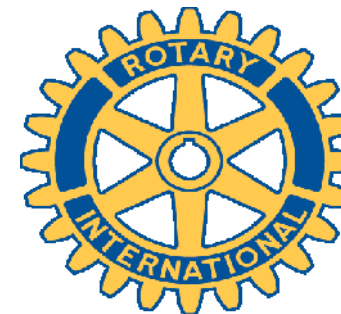

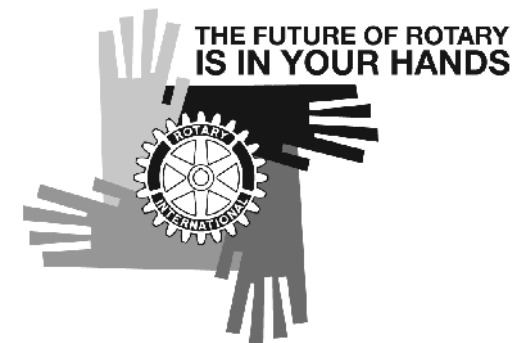
The Desert Wheel
