**Eddie Walneck**, a Rotary Ambassadorial Scholar to Hong Kong, was born and raised in Safford, AZ and was sponsored by the Rotary Club of Gila Valley. He graduated from Harvard with a degree in History specializing in Chinese and U.S. Foreign Policy. During



his ambassadorial scholarship year he received a Masters in International & Public Affairs from the University of Hong Kong. In his studies he focused on China's contemporary search for a global identity. Eddie noted that being an Ambassadorial Scholar was an exhausting experience, since he not only was studying at the university, he was involved in volunteer projects and also worked with Rotary Clubs in the region. His focus in his studies was on Chinese Nationalism and he feels that this gives the people a chance to participate in their country. 40% of China's GDP is in export and the country needs an 8% growth rate to keep up with population growth. There is a lack in domestic demand for its products and this is going to be more prevalent in the future because of a reduction in its population base, brought on by the one child policy. China's export products also suffer because they do not have “brand name” appeal.

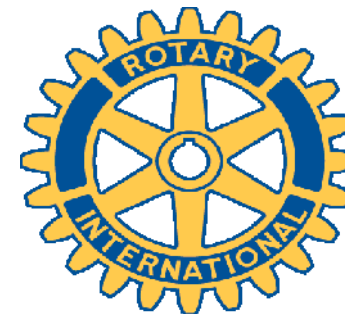

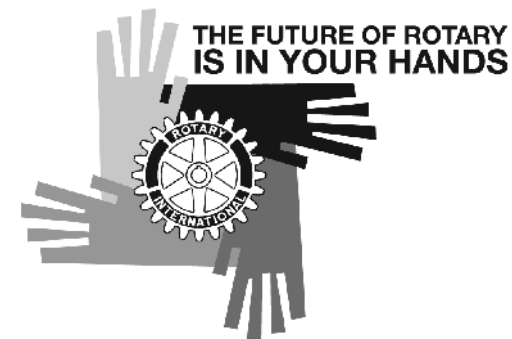
