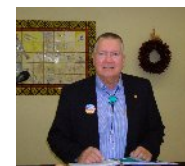
Rotary Crew to Paint at Continental School

Dr. Tom Purdon spoke on Friends of Madera



Canyon which was formed in 1987 as a response to the USFS's appeal to the public for volunteers to help preserve and protect the Canyon due to reduced budgets and funding. Since then, FOMC, an all volunteer non-profit organization, has contributed tens of thousands of hours and hundreds of thousands of dollars to guarantee that Madera Canyon remains one of our Country's premier destinations for nature lovers. FOMC volunteers work in the Canyon cleaning picnic areas and stream beds, monitoring trail conditions and many other tasks.



Dr. Purdon also spoke on the possible intrusion of mining in the Santa Rita Mountains area. He noted that "Save the Scenic Santa Ritas" is a non-profit organization that is working to protect the Santa Rita and Patagonia Mountains from environmental degradation caused by mining and mineral exploration activities. In the past, mining was a significant contributor to Arizona's rural economy, but mining now contributes less than 1% to our state economy. The income to this area from recreation, tourism, and birdwatching far exceeds the economic benefit from mining.

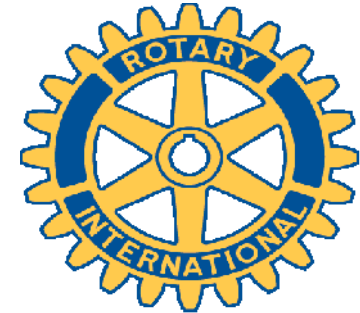

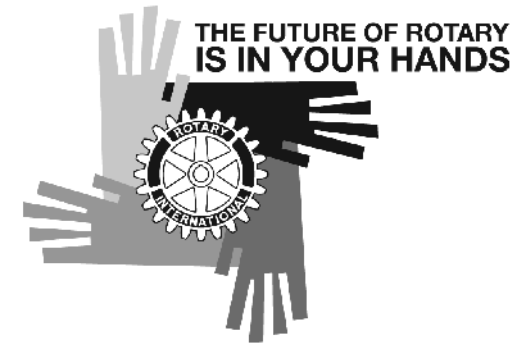
Desert Wheel
