**Program – Fire Chief
Simon Davis**

Chief Davis has been with the Green Valley Fire District since 2000. He was born in SW England but lived in Zambia until 1981.

He is a graduate of the U of A mining engineering program; he started his career in fire fighting as a volunteer.



Chief Davis spoke mostly about the 911 emergency system and the best way to use it. Dialing 911 gets you an operator in Tucson who connects you to medical, fire, or sheriff service. You need to be ready with your address or location and a clear statement of the problem. Since there are only 4 ambulances in Green Valley and they are almost always in use, the average time per call is 2 hours. The fire trucks, which carry all the same emergency medical equipment, stay local. If the call is medical, take with you ID, a list of medications, and doctor contact information. **Don't** take your wallet and credit cards. Davis warned us to call 911 instead of trying to drive to a fire station. Call 529-9200 for snakes, 393-7505 for smoke detector service.
