Program – Melody Webster, Valor Hospice

Melody Webster has been in the area since 1957 and spent 30 years in property management. After her mother’s illness she became community liaison for Valor Hospice, which has a service area stretching from Nogales to Phoenix to Globe. She said that while 90% of people would prefer to die at home, 50% die in hospitals, 25% in nursing homes, and only 25% at home.



Hospice provides care and support for people in the last phase of terminal illness, affirming death as a normal part of life (neither hastening nor postponing it), and focusing on quality of life for the whole family. Services range from case management to pharmaceuticals to equipment and supplies to grief support. Hospice is covered by Medicare and insurance, is not just for the last few days of life, and you don’t have to give up your primary physician. For more information call 520-399-0200.
