Foundation Minute – Andy Heideman

Andy read a letter from Rotary International leadership about Haiti relief. Past Governor of District 7020, which includes Haiti, Dick McCombe, said Rotary was in a good position to help because there were already 33 projects going to provide water, sanitation, medical care, and education. Over 50,000 lbs of medical equipment and supplies have been flown in on 55 planes to cities other than the ruined Port-au-Prince to bypass logistical problems. The UN estimates over 200,000 people have died so far.

Rotarians who wish to contribute funds or goods can visit the RI website or contact the International Service Programs Section at relief@rotary.org to learn about recovery efforts. The Rotary Foundation has established a Haiti Relief Fund, details on the RI website. Rotarians are encouraged to work with experienced relief organizations like UNICEF, Red Cross, and Shelterbox.

Ms. Meetz has been Executive Director of the ACLU in Arizona since 2006. This year the ACLU celebrates 90 years of fighting for civil rights. They've defended the great – Rush Limbaugh against government access to his medical records – and the small – the Safford 13-year-old who was strip searched by school administrators looking for ibuprofen. They were involved in the Skopes Monkey Trial about teaching evolution, Brown v. Board of Education that ended segregated schools, and Miranda v. Arizona – who today doesn't know their Miranda rights? The ACLU works to make policies transparent and to assure accountability. They believe we can be both safe AND free.
