Our APF goal is \$9,000. To date we've contributed \$7,050, 78% of our goal in 63% of our year.

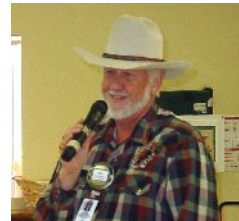

Program

Chad Fretz – Freeport McMoRan

With a BS in environmental engineering, Fretz has primary responsibility for environmental and land programs at the Sierrita Mine, which occupies 35 square miles, employs 1000 people, and has a life of 38 years. It produces 34,000 tons of ore daily by drilling and blasting. One by-product, copper sulphate, is used in pesticides. Another, the rare earth element rhenium, is used as a hardener for steel.

The 3500 acre tailings impoundment has created a sulfate plume in the ground water. Freeport McMoRan has spent \$13 million for 2 new wells, has bought 8000 acres of state land southwest of the mine for new tailings with different drainage, and in 2006 signed a Mitigation Order of Consent that requires well water sulfate levels be brought below 250 mg/L. A community advisory group oversees the mitigation process.

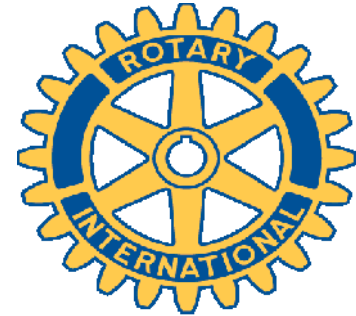

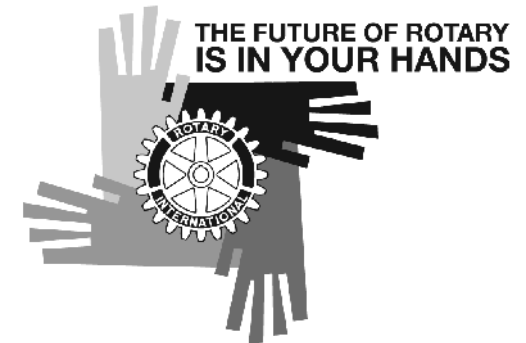
