Program – John Dinkelman, US Consul in Nogales, Sonora.

Dinkelman began his 21 years in foreign service as a Vice Consul in Yugoslavia; he left there in 1991 because of the civil war. He met his wife during 2 years as a very junior staff assistant at the US Embassy in London and spent the next few years in Micronesia and the Marshall Islands.



During the Colin Powell era Dinkelman was a “boot camp” instructor for US diplomats at the State Department. When his son was diagnosed as having a form of autism, he found the job of Consul in Nogales to be perfect for his family.

Dinkelman finds the Mexican people to be warm and hospitable. His job is to represent the US, see to the needs of US citizens in Mexico, and foster the *legitimate* movement of people and goods between the 2 countries. He told an interesting tale of trucks backed up at the Port of Entry, no one knew why. In shorts and flip-flops he stepped over the border and with just a few questions and suggestions got the border reopened and traffic moving again. He sees his present assignment as a learning adventure in his career.

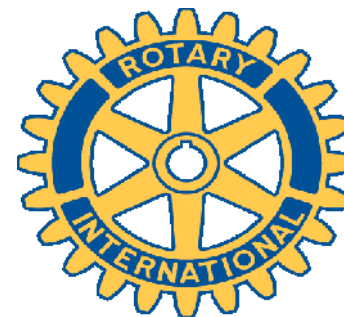

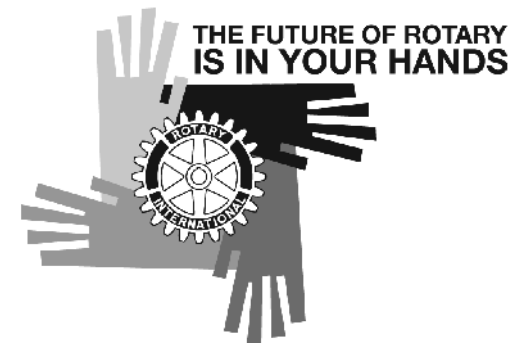
