President Mitch reported on UN Water Day March 22, saying more people die each year from polluted water than from all

forms of violence, including war. The discharge of 2 billion tons of waste water, which includes fertilizer run-off, sewage, and industrial waste, fuels the spread of disease and damages ecosystems. Half the world's hospital beds are filled with people suffering from water-borne illnesses. Improving water quality is one of Rotary's missions, of course.

Program – La Posada – The Country Club of Retirement Facilities

Past Club President Mark Dugan, a vice president at La Posada, and **Steve Kolnacki**



presented an overview of La Posada. The facility opened in 1987, has 714 residents, 124 garden homes, 320 apartment homes, 82 assisted living suites, 30 memory care rooms, 58 skilled nursing beds, and 536 employees. In addition to medical services to residents, La Posada serves over 5000 outpatients each year.

In 2002 La Posada provided meeting room space or leadership for 30 community organizations; by 2009 that had grown to 65. They've held concerts to help support Casa de Esperanza and hosted our own Christmas Party.

Previous nursing homes followed a hospital model; La Posada developed a person-centered care model. **Steve** described their assisted living as "your own apartment with a little help." He also showed pictures of the new shopping area, including the popular Posada Java. The picture above is the "central park" meditation garden.

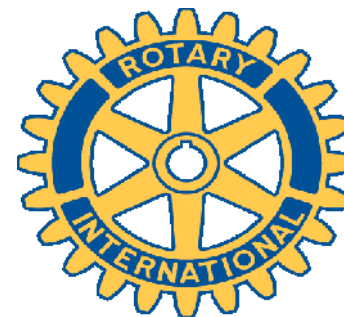

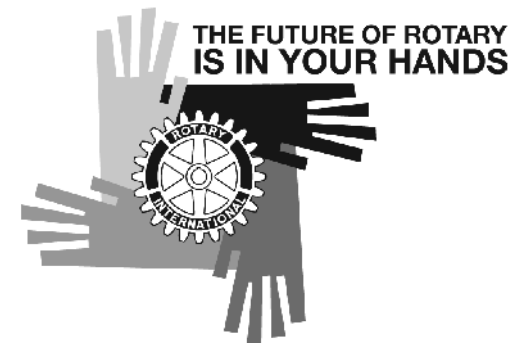
