Program – Hope Along the Border

Bill Stevens, a former Rotarian himself, spoke to the Club about Cuirim House, a project just over the Mexican border much like a Celtic monastery, which consists of a chapel, a dormitory with space for 60 people, a cafeteria that serves breakfast to poor kids, a drug rehab center, a soccer field that gives children a safe place to play, all brought about by **Brian Donahue**, a former banker turned pastor. **Brian** brought youth groups from Virginia to Nogales, Mexico to teach them about service. He moved to Rio Rico and bought land in Mexico for the project. Part of the purpose of Cuirim House is to empower Mexicans to help other Mexicans, to “plant the seeds of service.”

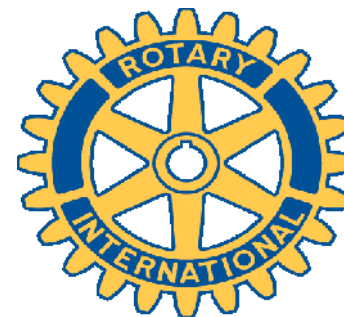

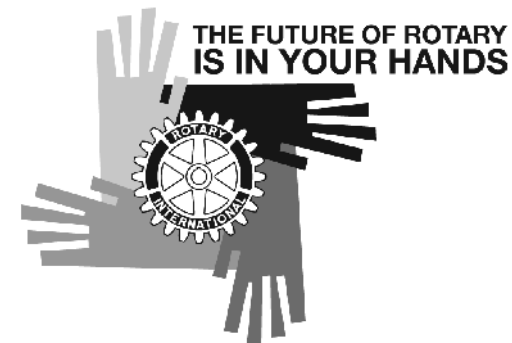
The Desert Wheel
