Program – Impressions of Haiti – Ken Bosma

Ken, who is now secretary at Valley Presbyterian, lived in Haiti from 1999 to 2002, working in schools and churches to train leaders. Haiti is the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere, with ½ the population scratching out a subsistence living in the rural areas. He described the Haitians as resourceful, resilient, independent, proud, joyous and content, and patient. They were the 2nd republic in the West (1804), the 1st black republic in the world. Because of our own slavery issues, the US didn't recognize them until 1862. Their independence is captured in the phrase "a slave to no one," their patience in "little by little the bird builds his nest." Their world view is 80% Catholic, 20% Protestant, and 100% Voodoo. **Ken** used to think they needed education, business development, and to be like Americans. Now he thinks they need basic medicine and shelter, water and sanitation, and agricultural assistance.

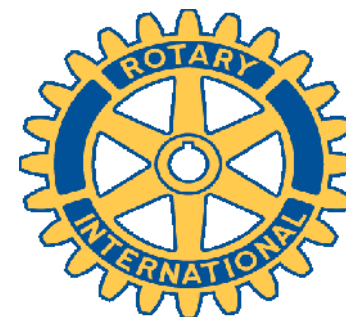
