GREEN VALLEY ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

The Green Valley Rotary Club will each year award up to two 4-year scholarships of \$1000.00 per year. Each will be payable to the student's school at the beginning of the instructional period.

The recipients will be graduating seniors of Sahuarita High School or any student who meets state graduating criteria and attends a private or parochial school or is home schooled in the Green Valley area.

The selections will be made by a committee composed of not less than three members of the Green Valley Rotary Club. They shall be the Vice President of the Club, who will chair the selection committee, the Treasurer of the Green Valley Rotary Club Foundation or their appointee, and the chairperson of the Vocational Service Committee. Substitutes for any of the above positions may be made by the Club President.

The evaluation process will be as follows:

1. Applications will be made available for students by March 1st.
2. Applications must be on the official Rotary Club form and be received by the Vocational Chairperson or his appointee by the 1st Friday of April.
3. The following criteria shall be used in the evaluation process:
 - a. High school achievement record
 - b. Extracurricular clubs and activities
 - c. Financial need
 - d. Personal interviews are permitted and are scheduled by the chair, if necessary, to complete the selection process
4. Winners will be announced at the 1st Club meeting in May. Students will be mailed notification on that date with a copy mailed to the Foundation Chair by the Vocational Chair. This shall include both winners and those not selected. All scholarship correspondence between the Club and the students will use the official Rotary Club mailing post office box address.
5. Before the school term begins the Foundation Treasurer will be responsible for mailing the award letter to the students and also a list of all the criteria needed to continue the scholarship for each school period or semester.
6. The Foundation Treasurer shall send the scholarship funds directly to the educational institution.
7. Upon completion of each semester or school term, the student shall submit grade cards or official letters showing satisfactory progress in the chosen field. In classes giving grades a "2.5 or C plus" average must be maintained. At least 12 semester units must be taken each term.
8. Class attendance must be continuous from semester to semester. The exception will be doctor certified illness.
9. Green Valley Rotary will coordinate with other local Rotary Clubs to avoid duplication of awards.
10. A Club representative shall make any school award presentations and the representative's name will be given to the high school registrar by May 1st.
